HAL NEW PUBLIC SCHOOL ANNUAL REPORT 2022-23

In the session 2022-23, HAL New Public School has a total strength of 873 students from Pre-Primary to Secondary Class with 41 teaching and non-teaching staff members. Excellence in education and fostering the love of learning is the hallmark of this school.

In March 2022 the first batch of class X comprising of 20 students will be appearing for their Secondary Examination.

The Highlights of the school are as follows:

1.PRINCIPAL TAKING CHARGE

Dr Om Singh Chundawat took charge as the Principal on 16th May 2022.

2. RECRUITMENT OF STAFF

*For the academic year 2022-23, All India Advertisement was released on job portals and 5 Teaching staff were appointed in tenure and two staff on Adhoc.

3. SCOLASTIC ACTIVITIES

- * Class X had begun their new session in March 2022. Classes were conducted till 08th April 2022, after which they had summer vacation.
- * Efforts are made to promote the holistic development of students encouraging them to participate in both, curricular and non- curricular activities.
- * School will apply for Kannada as Second language and IT (a vocational subject) as VI subject in class 9 and 10.
- * School is sharing worksheets with Answer key, Revision notes, Animated videos, Mind maps, NCERT solutions to students across all classes.
- * School has purchased Question paper generators for Teachers.

4.STUDENT ENRICHMENT PROGRAMMES

- * School conducted special assemblies for all classes like Yoga Day, World Environment Day, Save Soil Campaign and Kargil Day to enrich students with the significance of each of these.
- * Cyber Jagrukta Divas, a government initiative to raise cyber security awareness among students is observed on first Wednesday of every month through role plays, Display Board decoration, quiz etc.
- * HAR GHAR TIRANGA, 75th Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav, a programme considering the 75th year of Independence was highlighted at HNPS. The school had organised a Quiz Competition on the theme "Freedom Struggle". Eight students from four Houses participated in the Quiz. The winners and participants were felicitated with certificates.
- *The Ministry of Education's Innovation Cell had launched the School Innovation Council Program for schools across the country. Its aim is to foster the culture of Innovation, Ideation, Entrepreneurship, Creativity and Design thinking in schools. HAL New Public School launched the same on 02^{nd} June 2022 with its first project. All the aspects of the project from idea to execution was done by 20 students from class 8 to 10.

The first project was to create an awareness and build knowledge of students about the trees in the school campus, the students identified ten trees, researched information about them, compiled it in the form of a web page, generated a QR code to be put up on the trees to educate all students. This project has an innovative appeal with a blend of knowledge and technology.

* International Awards for Young People, is an exciting self- developmental International Programme for young people between14 -25 years. It equips its members with life skills, builds confidence and encourages them in make a difference to themselves and to the world. Four Volunteer teachers- Ms Aarti Deshpande, Ms Preet Kaur, Ms Kavitha Naik Keshav and Ms Brundha Ilangovan attended three days training programme on 24th,25th and 26th of August to become Award Leaders. Principal Dr Om Singh Chundawat lead the team as the Co Ordinator of the entire program. The school is now recognised as an Award Centre.

The school has conducted Orientation Programme on two days to introduce this course to students and parents. It's a pleasant surprise that many students are showing interest towards this programme.

*Students enrolment in Bharat Scouts and Guides – Two teachers Mr Vineeth Basu and Mr Srinivas M underwent the training Programme for seven days. Mr Srinivas M is nominated as Scouts Master of HNPS Subash Chandra Bose Scouts Troop for 32 students who have enrolled under him. Mr Vineeth Basu, HNPS Cub Master has 22 students enrolled under him.

5.PROMOTION OF SPORTS AND OTHER CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

* The department all Languages (English/ Hindi /Kannada and Non Scholastic Subjects – Department of Sports / Music /Art are equipping students with activities in their respective areas. Students are given a wide platform to showcase their potentials.

6.PARENT TEACHER MEETING

* PTM is being conducted after each assessment for parents to get the feedback of their wards' performance and introspecting the areas of improvement in the students' learning process.

7. TEACHER TRAINING

Teachers are undergoing various rigorous training recommended by the school and CBSE like the ART of Constructing Question Paper, 21st Century Learning Skills, Accreditation and Outcome Based Education which is incumbent on educators to commit themselves in in- depth teaching students in all levels of academics to address the great challenges of today and tomorrow.

8. AWARDS AND ACCOLADES

*Centre for Teaching Accreditation had conducted Teaching Professionals' Olympiad, an unique International level competition to reward, recognize and celebrate teachers. This exam is held in 14 subject tracks and 4 languages. Mrs Aarti Deshpande, TGT Mathematics at HNPS appeared for the same and secured the Third Rank which has a cash Prize of Rs.5000/.
