For those moving on to new adventures, we wish you all the best in your future endeavours. And for those returning next year, we can't wait to welcome you back!

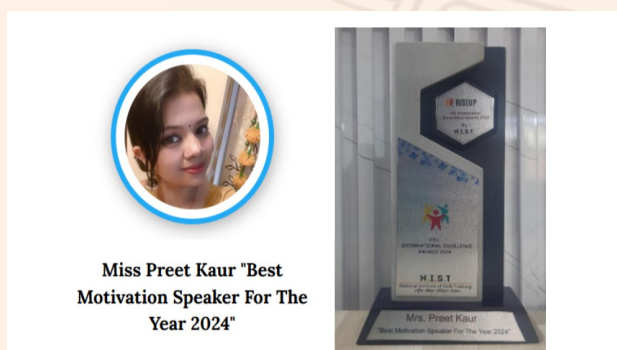
